LEAB MEMBER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 18-years-old.
- Must be or have been enrolled in Abode programs.
- Must have lived experience of homelessness to apply for membership. (Current or former experience.)
- Must participate in monthly LEAB member meetings.
- Must be willing to partner together and share feedback about service-related matters with staff members and employees of Abode programs.

Monthly Meetings: Two-hour, remote Zoom meetings – with lunch and tablets provided to members.

Monthly Stipend: Stipend of \$263 provided to volunteers – we thank you for your service!
