




# Feedback & Design

Big Picture Feedback Themes	
Broad Range of TAY Community Stakeholders	Include all foster youth community stakeholders, including current Hub users, Hub alumni, TAY service providers, and others within the TAY community
TAY-Centered Design, Programming, & Services	<ul> <li>Resources for TAY parents (child supervision, playground, cooking &amp; parenting classes, First Five, etc.)</li> <li>Space "to call your own"</li> </ul>
Need for TAY Housing	<ul> <li>Set-aside units for TAY in permanent affordable housing projects</li> <li>Connect housing units with THP+, Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP), and other subsidy programs</li> </ul>
Build Connection between New Hub and Housing	<ul> <li>Why is the new Hub co-located with housing?</li> <li>Housing and Hub should feel like a community</li> </ul>
Accessing Services and Programs at the New Hub	<ul> <li>Can TAY housing residents access the Hub and/or its services?</li> <li>Expand and augment existing programs (desire for learning kitchen, maker space, social lounge, etc.)</li> </ul>



General Comments	<ul> <li>Larger than the existing Hub</li> <li>Includes a centrally located lobby</li> <li>Space to celebrate youth accomplishments</li> <li>Fully accessible</li> </ul>	
Aesthetics	<ul> <li>Thoughtful, welcoming, and youth-centered</li> <li>Includes many murals</li> </ul>	
Facilities	<ul> <li>Large art room</li> <li>Multi-purpose classroom spaces useable for teaching, movies, and working out</li> <li>Workout room (flexible multi-use spaces)</li> <li>Large teaching kitchen</li> <li>Computer room</li> <li>More consulting rooms</li> <li>Decompression room</li> <li>Parent &amp; Child Room</li> <li>OYA Classroom</li> <li>Gaming area</li> </ul>

### **Project Background**




- The Hub Youth Center is a youth-led resource center which supports current and former foster youth;

- The County began looking for a site to build a "forever home" for The Hub and acquired the Parkmoor site in 2017


### • This site is a unique opportunity to:

### **Site Plan**




